Rules, Regulations and Expectations

Teams must locate and successfully accomplish 10 ChasePoints, receiving a punch at each. Some ChasePoints are mandatory, some offer different options, and some are open only for certain times. Some are nearby, and some require travel time. Some might have line-ups, some might be quick. Strategize accordingly!

Teams must participate in the event together and must remain within 50 feet of each other at all times, unless explicitly told otherwise by Event Staff. Participants are not allowed to use private modes of transportation, including bicycles, in-line skates, autos, taxis, magic carpet, etc. - unless provided or specifically instructed by Chase staff. Only CTA and you're own two feet can be used to get around.

Participants are allowed and encouraged to utilize technology, the Internet, GPS, etc. Teams are also encouraged to seek support from strangers, and to call friends and family. Participants of City Chase are asked to conduct themselves, and to respect the event rules, by the 'honor system.' On-site judges will also be present throughout the course, with authority to disqualify participants for rules infractions. In the case of any rules/conduct dispute, the judges' decision is final. The entire course and the finish line will close at 4:00PM. Please return to the finish line by this time regardless of how many stamps you have collected. Join your fellow Chasers at the Post-Party at Joe's Bar for an ice cold MGD64, stories, laughter, a slide show and prizing! Awards ceremony will be at 4:30.
